

# Spring Campout ACA ~ Lake Geneva ~

The ACA - Lake Geneva Campsite is located in Leesburg, Florida. This is a "cabin" campout complete with air-conditioning and indoor plumbing. **Directions from the South:** ●Take the Turnpike to the Leesburg/Clermont exit. ●Go north (right) to Leesburg via Hwy. 27 North. ●Travel about 15 miles through Leesburg to Fruitland Park. ●Proceed north until you pass the Florida Highway Patrol Station on the left. Look for Camp Geneva signs on the right and a Farm Store on the left as guides. ●Turn left at the Farm Store onto Spring Lake Road and follow Spring Lake Road for 3/4 of a mile to Pete Street. ●Take a right on Pete St. and an immediate left on to Via Marcia. ●Continue on this road through the main gate to the Administrative Office. If you go through the town of Lady Lake you've gone too far.
