- The Nation will supply cups and spoons, you bring the rest.
- Cooks may arrive as early as 9:00am.
- Chili must be ready for judging & serving no later than 1:30pm.
- Chili Ingredients: No pre-prepared ingredients allowed. Any recipe goes as long as it is made from scratch. Try to prepare at less 4 gallons to share w/other Tribes and family guests. We are not to serve the carnival visitors.
- Judging: Chili will be judged on both taste (70% of score) and presentation (30%).

This is going to be an awesome event, bring your whole Tribe to cook and cheer on your Tribe! We will have a great Carnival, with food and games available so bring potential new tribe members out to see a great program.
