- Chili must be ready for judging & serving no later than 1:00pm.
- Chili Ingredients: No pre-prepared ingredients allowed. Any recipe goes as long as it is made from scratch. Try to prepare at less **4 gallons** to share w/other Tribes and family guests.
- Judging: Chili will be judged on both taste and your cooking area separately.

This is going to be a great event, bring your whole Tribe to cook and cheer on your Tribe! We will have a great afternoon with food, bounce houses, inflatable slides and other games. So bring a potential new tribe members out to see our great program.
