Chili Cook-Off Guidelines

1. **Setup:** Each tribe has a 20'x20' cooking area. Bring an awning for shading.
2. **Supplies:** Nation will provide bowls, spoons, and paper towels for your tribe. You bring the rest.
3. **Arrival time:** Cooks may arrive as early as 10:00 AM. Chili must be ready for serving no later than 1:30.
4. **Chili Ingredients:** No pre-prepared chili ingredients allowed. Any recipe goes as long as it's fresh and made from scratch. We recommend cooking at least 2 gals so that you can share with other tribes.
5. **Judging:** Submit 1 quart for judging. Judging at 1:30 PM. Ties will be rescored within tying group.
6. **Prizes:** 1st place wins a free movie night for the whole tribe. 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place trophies.
