The cabins have comfortable bunk beds for 8 people and room for an additional 2 air mattresses. There is room around the cabins for tents for those who don't sleep in the cabin. There are also camper/RV hookups with 50 amp electric and water. These are located in the parking lot and away from the cabins. The facility has a lake, indoor auditorium, dining hall, and many other amenities.

There will be the time-honored Coup stick competition which includes a tribal skit, costume, craft and invitation judging and let's not forget the much anticipated war games and car race. During the Saturday evening bonfire we will have an award ceremony including the passing of the Coup stick. If it is time for your daughter to graduate the program this campout will include the "Breaking the Arrow" ceremony.
